In 2007, Rocky Turner, the founder of MFFO, found out from the Kenyan Volunteer Program Director with Global Volunteer Network, that underwear was a luxury and there are children in orphanages that do not have them. So she decided to go buy a few pairs herself. An amazing thing happened, a stranger at the store heard what she was doing and emptied her wallet and gave \$19 to her. Rocky was able to walk out of the store with 50 pairs of underwear! That day, Underwear For Africa was born! And today over 5000 pairs have been collected and passed out in orphanages, schools, and refugee camps in Uganda and Kenya.

The goal is simple. Collect as many packages of new and unopened pairs of girls and boys underwear, sizes 3T- 18, young mens and women’s also (for the teens), and send them off to Mothers Fighting For Others. Better yet, if you feel inspired to do more, you can have your own drive! They have made it really simple. They have designed flyers to put up or pass out. All You need to do is download them, set a date and place, and start collecting those underwear! Mothers Fighting For Others will keep you informed of just how many pairs of underwear they receive, and exactly what orphanages they will go to!
